Choir Visit to Guildford Cathedral on Saturday 22nd October

The choir are singing Choral Evensong at Guildford cathedral on 22nd October. The coach will leave from outside St Mary's at 0930, arriving at around 1200 at the cathedral. Choral Evensong will be sung at 1700, with the coach departing for home at 1800 and hopefully arriving in Bampton between 2000 and 2030.
